
Dear Parent/Carer,

This letter is to let you know about an internet safety project the school is running. In a recent assembly, we highlighted the issues surrounding digital footprints, and the importance of being aware that what you allow to be seen about yourself on the internet is visible to anyone in the world.

To encourage the young people in our care to be safe and well informed when using the internet, the school will be choosing pupils randomly and searching to see what information they reveal about themselves to the wider public. We will be using only basic internet tools to do this, and will only see information available to the whole world. We will use any information found appropriately, particularly to help students understand the importance of thinking about their online presence. The aim is to reduce, not increase, the spread of private information by raising awareness.

Pupils are welcome to opt out using the slip below and you as a parent can also request that they are not involved. We hope that if you do so, you will still take notice of issues the project highlights.
