**2017 Norfolk Children and Young People Health and Wellbeing Survey**

Our school, along with many others across Norfolk, has agreed to participate in a very important Health and Wellbeing Survey of Children and Young People. We have been asked to support the work of Norfolk County Council Public Health and the Norfolk Safeguarding Children Board and we stand to benefit substantially through our participation in the survey by gaining a better understanding of our students' needs.

The survey method that we are using has been developed by the Schools Health Education Unit, Exeter and has been in use now for over 30 years. Over 3000 schools have used the survey.

The questions concern a wide range of health behaviours, for example:

- Home and family
- Bullying
- Drugs\* and alcohol
- Healthy lifestyles
- Relationships and sex\*
- Leisure
